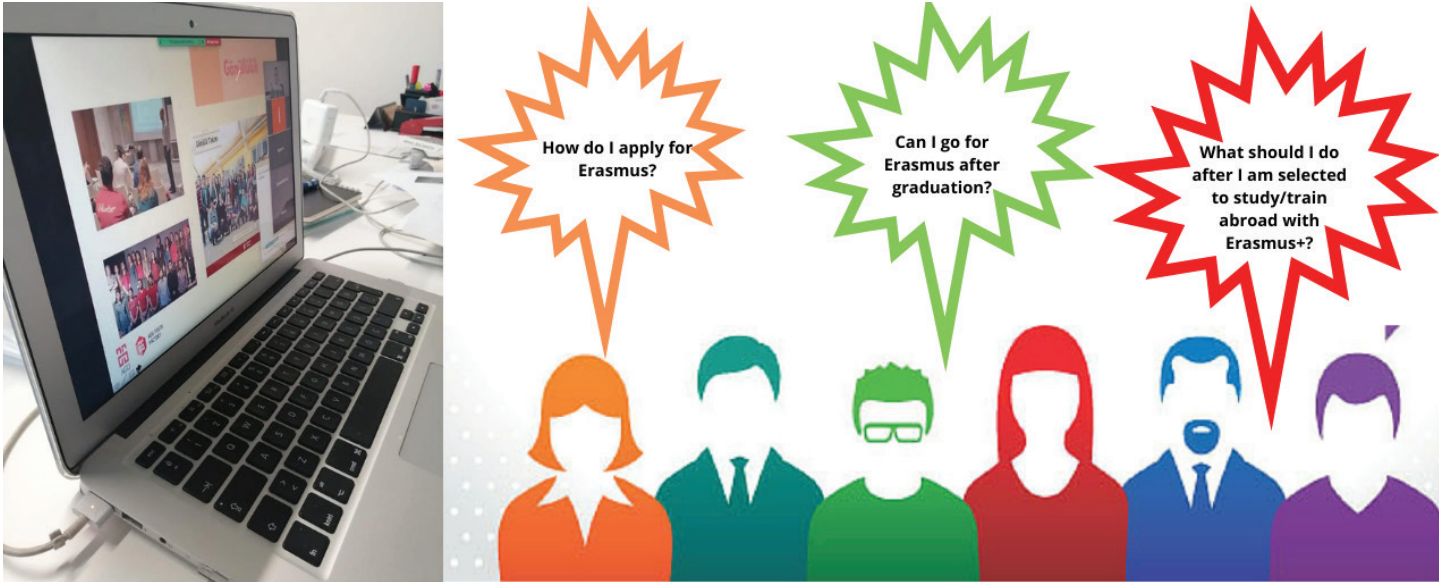


Online Info Sessions for Candidate Students and Newcomers
